## TEK to introduce a high watermark

After engagement with various shareholders and an internal review, the Board of Thorney Technologies Ltd (TEK) has reached in-principle agreement with the Investment Manager, Thorney Management Services Pty Ltd, to implement a high watermark for TEK under the terms of the TEK investment management agreement, for the purpose of calculating the payment of future performance fees, subject to compliance with the ASX Listing Rules and any required approvals.

The inclusion of a high watermark is proposed to take effect from 1 January 2024 and any future performance fees calculated will be subject to the high watermark of net tangible assets per share after that date.

The introduction of the high watermark better aligns the interests of the Investment Manager with those of TEK's shareholders. It also represents a further initiative aimed at reducing the prevailing share price to NTA discount and bringing it more into line with market practice.

The performance fees payable under the TEK investment management agreement are calculated each half year.
