CHINESE GOVERNMENT INITIATIVES IN RARE EARTHS

Lynas Corporation Limited (ASX:LYC, OTC:LYSDY) CEO Amanda Lacaze has welcomed Chinese media reports of further government initiatives to improve environmental practices and to reduce illegal Rare Earths mining in China.
