Process Plant Training for Papua New Guinea

A consortium led by the Enga Children's Fund, Orion Group and Site Group International announced that the company will launch a new Process Plant Training facility in Papua New Guinea. This will cater for specialised manpower needs for the mining and petroleum industry which is currently dominated by foreign workers.

Mr Isaac B. Lupari CBE, speaking on behalf of the Consortium said the feasibility study for the development of a multi-million dollar training hub, to be located in Port Moresby at the South Pacific Employment Institute (Formerly POMCTF), is almost completed and construction will commence in 2015.

This training plant will be built by Site Group International Energy Division (SGI Energy), which has deployed similar facilities in economies such as Myanmar.

“We recreate the Operation & Maintenance (O&M) workplace in a safe and controlled environment so that new and experienced Technicians and Supervisors can develop their practical skills and enhance their competence so as to meet the expectations of the oil and gas industry.” says Phil Costelloe, Director of SGI Energy.

Mr Lupari said we are very happy to partner with Site, who are fully conversant with current international best practices and provide workforce development.

The services offered under Site Group include

- designing and developing competence frameworks,
- competence profiles for the development and assessment of technical personnel
- developing and aligning competence based technical curriculum to match the requirements of clients and industry
- Short Training Courses (Technical & Safety)
- Technician Apprenticeships

The O&M training program incorporates commissioning, control room management, plant maintenance, behavioural skills and emergency response. The program ensures that the trainees are ‘job-ready’ and shortens the lead time for them to become competent at a client’s facility. This is particularly of importance when regulators require evidence of ‘Operational Readiness’, including competent personnel, prior to the issue of their Licence to Operate.

“This is a real opportunity for Papua New Guinea to participate in the ongoing benefits of the oil and gas industry long after the construction phase is complete. This program will create long term sustainable employment for Papua New Guineans as well as an ongoing

role within the global oil and gas industry” said Isaac Lupari Director of South Pacific Employment Institute.

Terry Mair, COO Orion Group said “The training of Papua New Guineans for highly skilled positions, which have previously eluded them, is now a real possibility. This process not only gives PNG Nationals the opportunity to gain the required technical skills, but also empowers them to fill high level, well paid, positions. We are delighted to be a key partner of this initiative, building upon the great success of previous collaborations between Orion, Site and the Enga Childrens Fund.”

The Facility

The South Pacific Employment Institute (SPEI) occupies the former Port Moresby Construction Training Facility (POMCTF) built by Exxon for the PNG LNG Project.

SPEI is located 10 minutes drive from the Port Moresby CBD and includes the following training facilities:

- (6) x two storey accommodation blocks (capacity for 250+ personnel)
- Two storey administration building
- (12) Classrooms with capacity for 20 persons per classroom
- (2) x Fully equipped training workshops (combined 2500m² on undercover area)
- Full catering facilities – Trainee mess, laundry, and recreational facilities
- Comprehensive inventory of training equipment



The Facility

In addition to the current facilities, the SGI Energy Division will establish a 'Safe Live Plant Environment' (SLPE) and associated equipment to train Oil & Gas Process and Maintenance personnel.

The recent completion of the US\$19B PNG LNG facility but Exxon and other significant Oil & Gas projects in development by Total, Talisman Energy, highlight the current and future need for a competent workforce in the Oil & Gas Industry.



The Facility

In addition to the 'Safe Live Plant Environment' (SLPE)' various training skids and equipment for specialist technical training will also be set up at the facility. This will provide a unique capability to PNG and enable development of a future workforce.

Specialist Oil & Gas Training will included, but not limited to the following:
