Philippines Training – Petrosea Training Contract and Ipatas Update

The Directors of Site Group International Limited (“Site”, ASX:SIT) are pleased to announce the arrival of 30 Petrosea candidates at the Site Skills Training Clark Freeport Zone Facility for the commencement of a three month Certificate III in Engineering Mechanical Trade (Diesel Fitting) program.

The Heavy Diesel Maintenance Program has been designed to up-skill Petrosea mechanics to an Australian standard Certificate III with the skills to be utilised maintaining Petrosea’s large heavy vehicle maintenance program.

Commenting on the agreement, CEO and Managing Director Vern Wills stated “the program is another step for the international training operation, utilising multiple related parties to deliver a training outcome for individuals to utilise their skills in their own country”

“Site Skills Training will work with Monark Caterpillar and the Monark Foundation to complete training, utilising the skills of Australian trainers, the Monark Caterpillar trainers and with use of the full range of training equipment located at the facility.”

With the third group of PNG Nationals participating in the Ipatas program having arrived at the end of November, 120 PNG nationals from the Enga Province are now undertaking and completing an Australian Certificate II standard in Engineering (Mechanical Trade), Engineering (Fabrication Trade) and a Certificate III standard in Hospitality (Commercial Cookery).

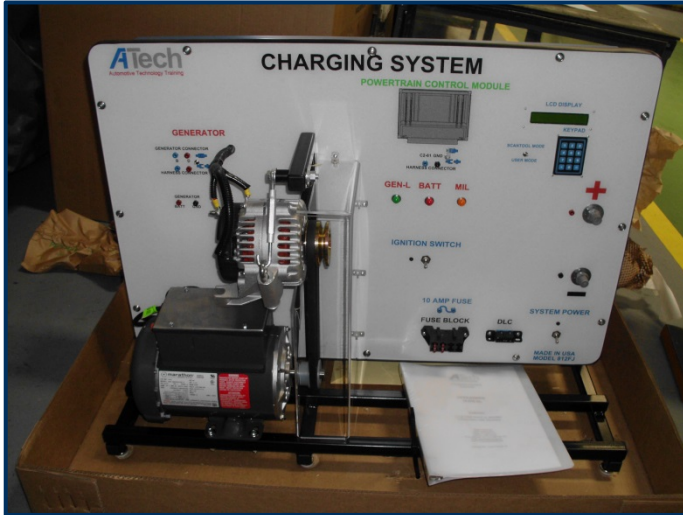
The program includes four to six months of facility based training with a further six to eight months of On-the-Job Training (OJT) for the respective courses.

Commenting on the Ipatas program, CEO and Managing Director Vern Wills stated “it is good to see that all Ipatas program candidates have arrived and settled in with the commencement of their training.”

Continuing, he stated “It is with keen interest that we watch the progression of the students through the program, looking to utilise the model as a platform for similar training with other jurisdictions in to the future.”

“We are very pleased with the interaction and attention of the multicultural campus and how all candidates are interacting within the Site community” Mr Wills said.

There will be 150 students at the Site Skills Training facility continuing training over the Christmas and New Year period, in addition to students participating in general programs.
