Commencement of Ipatas Foundation Training Program.

The Directors of Site Group International Limited ("Site", ASX:SIT) are pleased to announce the first 40 PNG Nationals arrived at the Site Skills Training Clark Freeport Zone campus yesterday, marking the commencement of the Ipatas program.

The agreement, signed at the end of May, is to deliver training for 120 PNG nationals from the Enga Province to an Australian Certificate II standard in Engineering (Mechanical Trade), Engineering (Fabrication Trade) and a Certificate III standard in Hospitality (Commercial Cookery).

The program includes four to six months of facility based training with a further four to six months of On-the-Job Training (OJT) for the respective courses.

The first 40 PNG Nationals comprises the Heavy Diesel Engineering (Mechanical Trade) candidates who will be spending 6 months at the facility, with the remaining candidates expected to arrive within the month of November.

The arrival marks a promising expansion in the scope of training services which Site Skills Training is able to offer to the international market, with increased demand by sovereign nations in up-skilling their nationals.

Commenting on the commencement, CEO and MD Vern Wills stated "the program is being closely watched by other regions in PNG, as well as nations amongst the Southeast Asian archipelago, who have expressed interest in this style of training."

Continuing, he stated "With a number of new projects appearing throughout these regions, local governments have shown great interest in up-skilling their communities to improve local employability."

"Project stakeholders and governments have come to expect a minimum standard of training and safety for their employee's and there are substantial economic and civil incentives for both parties to look to skill local communities".

"This is a further extension of previous training undertaken by Site such as the Palawan out of work youth program a substantial initiative of the Malampaya Foundation in conjunction with Shell, Chevron and PNOOC."

"We look forward not only to the successful delivery of this project, but also to the promising opportunities this presents for all parties involved in to the future."
