Acquisition of Romea Training

The Directors of Site Group International Limited ("Site", ASX:SIT) are pleased to announce the acquisition of Romea Training, a specialist Registered Training Organisation in the petrochemical processing and high pressure (HP) gas transmission industry.

Central to Romea Training has been the development of customised technical training courses and delivery of apprenticeship/traineeship programs. Romea has also developed its own e-learning systems to enable flexible delivery to corporate clients.

Romea Training commenced in 1997 and is well recognised in the high pressure gas transmission sector, and over many years has developed and implemented training programs for some of the largest owners and operators of high pressure gas pipelines in Australia.

The acquisition of Romea provides Site with a platform to deliver the same courses under a new training arm called Site Energy Training while utilising existing Site Skills Training facilities and operational and administrative teams.

As part of the acquisition, Romea Training's Managing Director, Mr Leng Saw, will continue with Site as Training Manager of Site Energy Training. Mr Saw is a Mechanical Engineer with significant experience across Energy, Mining and Construction.

Site Energy Training will be a specialist division to provide training across the full spectrum of the energy sector, including upstream, downstream processing, through to power generation and HV/LV transmission. Providers in this space are generally segmented small Registered Training Organisations with limited geographic presence. Through existing Site Skills Training facilities, there is an opportunity for Site Energy Training to deliver tailored upstream, midstream and downstream PMA and UEG training packages for major clients in key Oil & Gas regions in Australia, namely Gladstone, Darwin and the Northern WA regions. Additionally the opportunity is significant for our Clark facility and other international jurisdictions where Site has client relationships eg Indonesia and PNG.

Courses which will commence in the coming months will include Hazard Awareness, High Voltage, Gas Testing Atmospheres and Breathing Apparatus, Oil & Gas and LNG fundamentals and the APPEA accredited Common Safety Training Program.

This new business unit will have a particular focus on the LNG Industry as many of the major projects under construction will soon be transitioning from construction to production.

Site CEO Vern Wills commented "this acquisition will leverage the hard work of the Romea founders and Site management and staff by overlaying the significant capabilities over Site Groups very significant client base"

“Importantly for Site it provides a significant competitive advantage and an essential service to our customers.”

The business has been acquired with a combination of cash and equity consisting of \$750,000 upfront cash and 2,000,000 Site Shares which will be issued at market price and escrowed for up to 3 years. In addition a further performance incentive of up to 3,000,000 Site shares will be issued subject to achievement of revenue milestones at the end of year 3 post the transaction.
