Clarification on JRV Quarterly Report to 30 June 2009 Re: page 3

Dear Sir,

Reference to 100 million tonnes at a grade of 1% nickel, on page 3 of the JRV Quarterly Report 30 June 2009, was not related to any expectation of resources at the Company's tenement at Nyngan, NSW, but to the increase in parameters now considered necessary for the High Pressure Acid Leach (HPAL) process to have a chance of being economic. As such, Clause 18 in the JORC code is not relevant to the reference.

The recent closure of the Ravensthorpe mine in Western Australia was a 'wakeup' call for all prospective nickel laterite miners. This is the basic reason behind JRV's ongoing search for a better method of treatment.

JRV has been lucky enough to be invited to participate in ground breaking research i.e. hydrochloric acid test work in Canada. There are other alternatives but JRV believes the Canadian proposals are the best on offer at the present time, especially as JRV is the sole representative of the nickel laterite industry.
