Opening of Underground Mine Environment

The Directors of Site Group International Limited ("Site") are pleased to announce, in conjunction with OceanaGold, the opening of the Underground Mine Training Environment at Site Skills Training in the Philippines.

The multi-million dollar environment was built with a USD 1 million contribution from OceanaGold and strongly supported by Monark Caterpillar, Mynesight, Orica, Indodrill, Immersive Technologies and Minearc.

With 250 metres of metalliferous tunnelling, the environment has been built for competency assessment and training of Underground Mine Personnel across a range of programs designed for inexperienced persons through to experienced and specialised crews.

The training environment replicates conditions which are experienced underground allowing the training to be more impactful with higher levels of competency retention.

Competencies able to be developed for new workers include services extensions, venting, ground support encompassing bolting, meshing and shotcreting, vehicle operations underground, CABA operations, dewatering, rigging, lifting and health and safety skills. Experienced workers can gain competence in drilling, blasting, emergency response/ rescue and firefighting. All these skills are developed according to company standard operating procedures without affecting mine production while training is occurring.

As a prime example of the benefits of this facility, specialised Emergency Response Teams are able to simulate different situations to refine and practice their emergency response procedures. These drills currently may require a working mine to stop production. Having the underground mine environment allows teams to be trained at Site Skills Training with equivalent or better outcomes and without affecting production, saving time and cost.

The environment represents a significant community service commitment suitable for the development of safe, competent work practices and is open for training for all mining companies, contractors and industry participants from the Philippines and globally.

The opening saw over 150 dignitaries including representatives of OceanaGold, Local and Foreign Governments, Industry Councils, Owners, Operators and Contractors, viewing the capabilities of Site Skills Training and the Underground Mine Environment.

OceanaGold personnel have commenced training for the Didipio Mine in the northern Philippines, with capability for the environment to support over 100 candidates at any one time.

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
