AUSMEX COMPLETES FIRST AND SECOND SALE UNDER THE CLONCURRY OPTION AGREEMENT

- ➤ Ausmex Mining Group Limited (the "Company") is pleased to announce that they have successfully Completed the First and Second Sale under the Cloncurry Option agreement with Queensland Mining Corporation Limited (QMC) as per the notice of exercise (see ASX Announcement dated 10 May 2017). Details of the terms of the Cloncurry Option Agreement are included in the prospectus dated 16th March 2017.
- ➤ The Company have acquired a combined interest of 80% in an incorporated Joint Venture with QMC which includes a highly prospective suite of Exploration Permits, Mining Licenses and processing plant within the Cloncurry region.
- The Company is now finalising an intensive exploration plan focusing on identified gold, copper and cobalt targets within the Cloncurry suite.
- ➤ Exploration plans are also in final stages for the 100% owned, ~970 SqKm South Australian tenement EL5851, consisting of numerous historic Copper, Gold, & phosphate prospects in the Burra region, and adjacent to the Monster Mine (produced 10% of worlds copper in 1851).
- ➤ The Ausmex team will continue to review and assess new opportunities, building a strong suite of highly prospective, near term production mineral assets.
