Completion of on-ground test work at Tala Hamza

Terramin Australia Limited (ASX: TZN) (**Terramin**) is pleased to announce that it has completed all the geotechnical and hydrological test work at the Tala Hamza Zinc Project.

The completion of the on-ground test work follows the finalisation of the water pump tests from a series of hydrological holes recently drilled at Tala Hamza. The purpose of this program is to confirm the hydrogeological conditions in preparation for the final design of the mine and to further determine any environmental impact.

The results from this hydrological drilling program are very positive to the extent that they show that water levels in and around the ore body will be substantially less than previously modelled. This will

reduce the costs associated with water management. The receipt of these results will allow Terramin to finalise the mine design and environmental impact management plans.

This follows the completion of the geotechnical drilling in May 2017. This programme provided data to confirm the location of the portal and ventilation shafts.

The completion of these work programs finalises the on-ground work necessary to complete the revised feasibility studies.

The project team will now focus on the following objectives:

- completing and delivering the revised Definitive Feasibility Study (**DFS**) to the projects partners (ENOF and ORGM);
- preparing and lodging the Environmental Impact Statement which, with the revised DFS, will be included in and support the application to mine to the Algerian Regulator.
