Sydney Airport Traffic Performance June 2017

Sydney Airport Managing Director and CEO Kerrie Mather said, “International traffic growth of 9.7% versus the prior corresponding period (pcp) is a fantastic result, and represents our strongest monthly result this year. Domestic traffic also grew strongly at 3.6% above the pcp, contributing to overall traffic growth of 5.8% for the month.

“International and domestic traffic continues to be driven by higher load factors and larger aircraft. Our international markets continue to perform well, particularly to China, and follows the Open Skies agreement between the two countries in December 2016. Sydney Airport is well placed to benefit from continued passenger growth from China, with a recent study showing that Australia has risen to the fourth most desirable leisure destination for Chinese nationals to visit in coming years.³

“We are pleased to report strong international growth of 7.7% for the six months to 30 June 2017 as compared to the pcp, and will report our financial results associated with the half year on 22 August 2017.”

Key point

- Asiana will operate 495-seat A380 aircraft for the 2017 Northern Winter season, adding 40,000 seats as compared to the pcp on their Sydney-Seoul service.
