GENERAL INFORMATION

Voting Entitlements

The Company has determined that in accordance with regulation 7.11.37 of the Corporations Regulations 2001 (Cth) that for the purposes of the AGM (including voting), shares will be taken to be held by those persons recorded in the Company's register as at 11:00 am Tuesday 17th October 2017 (AEDT).

Proxies

A shareholder entitled to attend and vote at the AGM is entitled to appoint not more than two proxies, who need not be members of the Company. Where more than one proxy is appointed, each proxy should be appointed to represent a specified percentage or specified number of the shareholder's voting rights. If the appointments do not specify the percentage or number of votes that each proxy may exercise, each proxy may exercise half the votes.

Fractions of votes will be disregarded.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

These Explanatory Notes have been included to provide information about the items of business to be considered at the Company's AGM to be held on Thursday, 19 October 2017 at 11:00am (AEDT).

1. Financial Statements and Reports

As required by section 317 of the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth), the Company's Financial Statements, Directors' Report and Auditor's Report will be presented for consideration. No resolution is required for this item, but shareholders will be given the opportunity to ask questions and to make comments on all aspects of these reports. Shareholders will also have a reasonable opportunity to ask the Auditor questions relevant to the conduct of the audit and the preparation and content of the Independent Audit Report.

2. Remuneration Report

A resolution for the adoption of the Remuneration Report must be considered and voted on in accordance with section 250R(2) of the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth).

The Remuneration Report forms part of the Directors' Report in the Company's Annual Report. The Remuneration Report details the Company's policy on the remuneration of its Directors. The vote on the adoption of the Remuneration Report resolution is advisory only and does not bind the Directors or the Company. However, the Board will take the outcome of the vote into consideration when reviewing the remuneration practices and policies of the Company.

The Board recommends that shareholders vote in favour of the adoption of the Remuneration Report. The Chairman of the meeting intends to vote all available proxies in favour of the adoption of the Remuneration Report.

3. Election of Director

Election of Sam Brougham

Sam Brougham retires in accordance with ASX Listing Rule14.5 and clause 63 of the Company's Constitution and, being eligible, offers himself for election as an independent non-executive director. Mr Brougham was originally appointed to the Board in August 2014.

Mr Brougham has served as a non-executive director of the Company since his appointment to the Board.

Mr Brougham is currently engaged as a non-executive director of Ellerston Global Investments Limited and Ellerston Asian Investments Limited. He has over 31 years investment experience and is currently a Director of Ceres Capital, a private investment firm specialising in global equity investing he founded in 1999.

Prior to Ceres Capital, Mr Brougham worked at Structured Asset Management, a successful hedge fund he co-founded in 1993, focusing predominately on global equity markets. He was also a partner at JB Were prior to Structured Asset Management.

Mr Brougham spent his early career working for Price Waterhouse and received his economics degree from Adelaide University in South Australia.

The Board (other than the relevant Director in relation to his own election) recommends the election of Mr Brougham.

The Chairman of the Meeting intends to vote undirected proxies in favour of the election of Mr Brougham.

4. Election of Director

Election of Ashok Jacob

Ashok Jacob retires in accordance with ASX Listing Rule 14.5 and clause 63 of the Company's Constitution and, being eligible, offers himself for election as a non-independent executive director. Mr Jacob was originally appointed to the Board in August 2014.

Mr Jacob has served as a non-independent executive director and Chairman of the Company since his appointment to the Board.

Mr Jacob has over 30 year investment experience and is currently engaged as a Director and as Chief Investment Officer of the Manager. He has overall responsibility for, and plays a key role in the Company's investment decisions.

Mr Jacob has held prominent positions including Chief Executive Officer of the Consolidated Press Holdings Group and Managing Director of Thorney Holdings, then the investment arm for the Pratt Group. Ashok is an experienced board member and current appointments include Ellerston Asian Investments Limited, MRF Limited and Thorney Opportunities Ltd. Previous directorships include Crown Ltd, Publishing and Broadcasting Ltd, Challenger Financial Group Ltd, Fleetwood Holdings Ltd, Ecorp Ltd, CPH Investment Group Ltd, Folkestone Ltd and Snack Foods Ltd.

Mr Jacob holds an MBA from the Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania (1984).

The Board (other than the relevant Director in relation to his own election) recommends the election of Mr Jacob.

The Chairman of the Meeting intends to vote undirected proxies in favour of the election of Mr Jacob.
