Share Purchase Plan - Issue of Shares and Appendix 3B

Leading environmental and geotechnical services provider HRL Holdings Limited (ASX: HRL, "HRL" or "the Company") is pleased to advise of a strong investor response to its Share Purchase Plan Offer ("SPP Offer") announced on 31 October 2017.

HRL's SPP Offer announcement stated that once the Company had received applications to subscribe for \$1 million in new shares, the SPP Offer would close.

HRL advised on 8 November 2017 that it had received applications in excess of \$1 million, and as such, the SPP Offer closed on that date.

The Company advises that the SPP Offer was more than 1.58 times oversubscribed. The Directors have resolved that all applications will be scaled back to 63.132% of the shares applied for, in line with the excess value of application funds over the \$1,000,000 being offered.

The shares under the SPP Offer will be issued today. An Appendix 3B is attached in relation to the shares being issued.

Excess funds will be refunded to applicants by the share registry with cheques to be sent tomorrow.

HRL's Board of Directors would like to thank all shareholders for their support of the Company's growth plans.
