DIATREME COMPLETES PRIVATE PLACEMENT

Diatreme Resources Limited (ASX: DRX, Diatreme or the Company) is pleased to announce it has completed a private placement to sophisticated investors to raise a total of \$490,000 in capital through the issue of 24,500,000 fully paid ordinary shares at \$0.020 per share.

The proceeds from this placement will be used to further advance the Cyclone Zircon Project DFS and working capital.

The Directors are pleased with the outcome and wish to thank all applicants for their continued support of the Company.

After the allotment of the above shares, the Company will have 1,029,309,591 fully paid ordinary shares on issue. Diatreme also provides the following information under ASX Listing Rule 3.10.5A and 7.1A.4(b):

- (a) A total of 16,538,463 shares were issued pursuant to Listing Rule 7.1A (representing 1.61% of the post-placement capital) and 7,961,537 shares were issued pursuant to Listing Rule 7.1 (representing 0.77% of the post-placement capital).

The percentage of the post-placement capital held (in aggregate) is as follows:

- pre-placement security holders who did not participate in the placement - 91.18%
- pre-placement security holders who did participate in the placement – 7.61%
- participants in the placement who were not previously security holders - 1.21%

- (b) Diatreme considered the placement as the most efficient and expedient method for raising the funds required to achieve its stated objectives given the funding certainty. The Placement also allowed the Company to introduce two new sophisticated and professional investors to its register.

- (c) The placement was not underwritten.
