### GetSwift Limited (ASX:GSW)

GetSwift Limited (**Company**) advises that it has been served by law firm Corrs Chambers Westgarth Lawyers, on behalf of Shaun McTaggart, with class action proceedings (including an Originating application and Statement of Claim) against the Company in the New South Wales Registry of the Federal Court.

The McTaggart Statement of Claim, like the Perera Statement of Claim (announced on 21 February 2018) alleges the Company breached its continuous disclosure obligations and that it engaged in misleading and deceptive conduct and seeks damages as a result. The Company understands that Mr McTaggart is funded by litigation funder Vannin Capital. The McTaggart proceedings and the Perera proceedings cover broadly the same period of time (the McTaggart period is two days longer) and they are both brought as open class actions. Both proceedings are listed for hearing on 29 March 2018, at which time the Company will request the Court consider how to advance the competing proceedings between two plaintiff law firms and two litigation funders.

The Company will contest this action. Quinn Emanuel are engaged to defend the proceedings.

The Company will continue to keep shareholders informed of developments.
