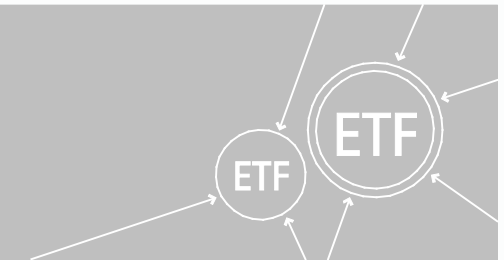

VEU is a share class of the Vanguard® FTSE All-World ex-US Index Fund (US Fund), which is traded in the form of CDIs* in Australia. As the filing in the US covers multiple funds, only the information relevant to the US Fund is included.
