The issuer of this SPDS and the PDS is ETFS Management (AUS) Limited ('ETFS') (ABN 13 150 433 828 AFSL No 466778), which is the responsible entity of, and issuer of Units in, the Fund.

The purpose of this SPDS is to update the PDS to reflect a change in the contact details of the Responsible Entity, to change the name of ETF Securities Limited, the global parent company of the Responsible Entity and to update other miscellaneous information in the PDS.

- In paragraph 3.1 on page 13, replace the paragraph commencing with 'ETF Securities Limited' in its entirety with:

ETFSC Capital Limited ("ETFSC") is a Jersey company which was incorporated under the Companies (Jersey) Law 1991 on 20 August 2004 and prior to 8 May 2018 was named ETF Securities Limited. Its registered office is Ordnance House, 31 Pier Road, St Helier, Jersey, JE4 8PW, Channel Islands. ETFSC is the ultimate holding company of a group of companies which prior to the sale of its European and U.S. businesses issued and provided management and other services to more than 300 exchange traded products similar to the Funds across Europe, Asia, Australia and the United States including 15 products currently quoted on the ASX. Immediately prior to the sale of its European and U.S. businesses in April 2018 funds under management across all products issued or managed by the ETFSC Capital Group totaled approximately US\$25 billion. The Responsible Entity has sufficient working capital to operate the Funds in accordance with this PDS.

- In paragraph 3.1 on page 13, replace the biography of Mr. Graham Tuckwell in its entirety with:

Mr. Tuckwell is the founder and chairman of ETF Securities Limited (now ETFSC Capital Limited). Prior to the sale of the U.S. and European businesses of ETF Securities in April 2018, Mr Tuckwell was director of ten other companies issuing exchange-traded commodities: Gold Bullion Securities Limited in Jersey, ETFSC Metal Securities Australia Limited, ETFSC Metal Securities Limited, ETFSC Oil Securities Limited, ETFSC Commodity Securities Limited, ETFSC Foreign Exchange Limited, ETFSC Hedged Commodity Securities Limited, Swiss Commodity Securities Limited, ETFSC Hedged Metal Securities Limited and ETFSC Equity Securities Limited. He was also a director of GO UCITS ETF Solutions plc and of its manager GO UCITS Management Limited in Ireland, a trustee of ETFSC Trust in the U.S., as well as the President and Chief Executive Officer of ETF Securities USA LLC. Assets under management immediately prior to the sale of those businesses were in excess of US\$25 billion. Previously, Mr. Tuckwell was the founder and managing director of Investor Resources Limited, a boutique corporate advisory firm which specialised in providing financial, technical and strategic advice to the resources industry. He has more than 20 years of corporate and investment banking experience. Prior to the above activities, Mr. Tuckwell was Head of Mining Asia/Pacific at Salomon Brothers, Group Executive Director at Normandy Mining responsible for Strategy and Acquisitions and Head of Mergers and Acquisitions at Credit Suisse First Boston in Australia. He holds a Bachelor

of Economics (Honours) and a Bachelor of Laws degree from the Australian National University.

- In paragraph 3.1 on page 13, replace the biography of Dr. Vince FitzGerald in its entirety with:

Dr. FitzGerald has been a Director of ACIL Allen Consulting Group Pty Ltd, an Australian consulting company in economics, public policy and economic and financial regulation. He has been a director of that company since April 2013. From 1989 to 2013 he was a director of a predecessor company - Allen Consulting Group Pty Ltd. Prior to that time, he was a senior government official in Canberra, his career involving assignments in the Treasury, Prime Minister and Cabinet, Finance (Deputy Secretary), Trade (Secretary) and Employment, Education and Training (Secretary). He is a well-known expert on the superannuation industry in Australia, and is a superannuation fund trustee. He was until April 2018 the President of the Board of Governors of the Australian National University Endowment for Excellence. He was a member of the Victorian State Council of the Australian Institute of Company Directors, and for a number of years until 2015 its President and a member of the Institute's national board. He is a Fellow of the Institute and of the Institute of Public Administration, Australia. He was until July 2017 a director of The Conversation Media Group Limited. He was formerly a director of ING Australia Holdings Limited and Chairman of its Audit and Risk Management Committees. He was previously a director of ETF Securities Limited prior to the sale of its European and U.S. businesses in April 2018. He holds a Bachelor of Economics (First class Honours in Econometrics and a University Medal) from the University of Queensland, a PhD in Economics from Harvard University, an Honorary Doctorate of Laws from Monash University and an Honorary Doctorate of Economics from the University of Queensland. Dr. FitzGerald was made an Officer of the Order in Australia in June 2016.
