# **Sydney Airport Traffic Performance May 2018**

Sydney Airport CEO Geoff Culbert said, "Passenger growth has remained solid, increasing 2.6% during the month of May compared to the prior corresponding period (pcp). International traffic grew 5.6%.

"Nationals from Vietnam (+24.3%) and the USA (+12.8%) recorded notably strong growth, with those from India (+9.1%) and China and Hong Kong (+6.3%) also contributing to the overall performance. Pleasingly, Australian growth was also strong at 6.7%. Overall international passenger growth was predominantly driven by the delivery of additional seat capacity.

"Domestic growth was up 1.1% compared to the pcp, driven by a 0.9 percentage point improvement in load factors, with airlines keeping capacity constant in May.

"The number of next-generation aircraft<sup>3</sup> serving international routes continues to grow, with 29% of movements in 2018 now using quieter, more fuel-efficient aircraft – this is a 25% increase in movements from 2017 and 260% compared to 2015."
