## APPENDIX 4C – QUARTERLY CASH FLOW REPORT – JUNE 2018

Adelaide, Australia, Monday 30 July 2018: Axiom Properties Limited (ASX:AXI) lodges the attached Appendix 4C Quarterly report for entities admitted on the basis of commitments for the quarter ended 30 June 2018.

Commentary is provided as follows:

- The Company held cash reserves of \$12.062 million at 30 June 2018.
- The Company's cash reserves for the June quarter increased by \$1.445 million as follows:
  - Net operating cash outflows for the June quarter were \$462,879.
  - Net investing cash inflows for the June quarter were \$10.452 million.
  - Net financing cash outflows for the June quarter were \$8.543 million.

As previously announced during the quarter, the Company successfully settled the sale of its 50% interest in the Churchill North Shopping Centre. The netted proceeds after senior debt and transactions costs and subscription of 7 million units in the purchasing Trust is reflected as an investing inflow.

As also previously announced during the quarter, shareholders approved at an Extraordinary General Meeting to return each shareholder an amount equal to \$0.02 per share as a Return of Capital. The total return to shareholders is reflected as a financing outflow.

The Company continues to strategically deploy its capital in its property portfolio including its Double Bay project in Sydney and Currie Street project in Adelaide, as well as investigating new opportunities expected to generate superior returns.
