Correction to Appendix 3Es

Cardno Limited (ASX:CDD) (**Cardno**) encloses 20 Appendix 3Es in replacement of the Appendix 3Es lodged between 25 June 2018 and 20 July 2018.

The Appendix 3E lodged on 25 June 2018 incorrectly stated the number of shares bought back on the previous trading day, 22 June 2018, as 65,000 for \$82,096.95. Cardno confirms that on 22 June 2018, it bought back 90,883 shares for \$114,787.96.

The Appendix 3E lodged on 29 June 2018 incorrectly stated the number of shares bought back on the previous trading day, 28 June 2018, as 32,600 for \$41,984.86. Cardno confirms that on 28 June 2018, it bought back 50,700 shares for \$65,295.47.

As a result of the inadvertent errors described above, the Appendix 3Es lodged between 25 June 2018 and 20 July 2018 incorrectly stated the maximum number of shares that may still be bought back by Cardno under the buy-back. Cardno confirms that the corrected Appendix 3Es includes the correct maximum number of shares.
