

# **Business Centre directions**

#### Address:

Level 6, Tower Two Collins Square 727 Collins Street Melbourne 3008



### **Please Access via Collins Street**

- 1. Walk under the bright yellow Dion Horstmans sculpture at the entry to Collins Square
- 2. Enter through the revolving doors on your left marked as "Tower One and Two"
- 3. Walk straight through the Tower One and Two Lobby to the Concierge Desk.
- 4. Please announce yourself and Concierge will make contact to let us know you have arrived.
- 5. Concierge will direct you to the Business Centre:
  - 6. Continue towards the end of the lobby until you see the escalators on your left
  - 7. Take the escalator up one level
  - 8. Enter the Business Centre through the sliding doors straight ahead.

## If you have come from our 767 Bourke Street Carepark

- 1. Enter the retail space via the revolving doors into Tower 4
- 2. Walk straight through the retail space to the escalators at the end and go up one level
- 3. Turn left through the revolving doors
- 4. Take the escalators on your right up one level
- 5. Announce yourself at the Business Centre found directly in front of you at the top of the escalator
