Note that FY2018 Gruden revenues of \$1.9m have been reported within the Entertainment Publications division and that FY2017 income from discontinued operations has been provided for comparison purposes.

To improve disclosure to the market, the Company has added additional information regarding the cost of gift card sales. Gift cards are sold within the Entertainment business and represent a significant revenue line for that business. However, due to the nature of these sales (resale of third party gift cards, where the discount provided by the retailer is passed on to Entertainment members) the margins on this revenue are small (less than 1% in FY18).

When reporting the Company's results for H1 FY2018, the Directors noted that a number of write-downs had been taken by the IncentiaPay Group related to non-cash assets on the balance sheet. In finalising the FY2018 results, the Directors have further assessed the future growth prospects and associated investment costs related to the Company's Bartercard business and have taken a further impairment charge against the assets of that business.

In relation to the Gruden business, the Company has taken a conservative view of the future contract signing rate within that business, as well as the investment required to fully integrate the mobileDen technology, and has decided to book an impairment against the business as at 30 June 2018.

5.2. Provision for restructure

In December 2017 IncentiaPay announced a restructure program in respect of geographical presence and the employee cost base. As at 31 December a provision was raised for \$4.5m, being for employee entitlements and occupancy costs. This was in addition to the \$0.3m of employee termination costs booked during the six month period to 31 December 2017.

During the six months to 30 June 2018 the Group has completed the following items from the restructuring plan:

- Amalgamated eight office locations
- Amalgamated and streamlined the Bartercard Australia and New Zealand (BCANZ) senior management team
- Restructured field teams for BCANZ
- Implemented two key automation projects enabling restructure of head office administration
- Created shared service support solutions for the Group's marketing, human resource, finance, project management and legal functions
- Suspended investment in ExportPlus and Bucgi operations
- Increased investment in AliPay operations
- Divested of Bartercard US Inc and negotiated an exit of the Bartercard UK operations

The above resulted in an impact of \$1.9m to the provision during the six-month period ended 30 June 2018. The remaining provision as at 30 June 2018 is \$2.6m. The annualized operating profit benefit resulting from restructure program initiatives completed to 30 June 2018 is in the order of \$3.7m.

5.3. Discontinued operations

In line with the restructuring program announced on 22 December 2017, IncentiaPay divested of interests in Bartercard US Inc on 31 May 2018, and negotiated an exit of the Bartercard UK operations. These actions had the following impacts:

- Reclassified \$0.8m of losses during FY2018 to discontinued operations; and
- Booked impairments and losses on sale of \$2.6m against US and UK assets.

5.4. One-off balance sheet adjustments

The FY2018 results were impacted by the following one-off adjustments to the Group's balance sheet:

Understatement of other liabilities by \$0.4m as disclosed in the H1 FY2018 report



- Overstatement of trade receivables by \$0.5m as disclosed in the restatement of the H1 FY2018 report announced to the market on 17 July 2018
- Other minor adjustments amounting to \$0.1m

5.5. EGM costs

During FY2018, Incentia Pay Ltd held two Extraordinary General Meetings.

The first was held on 3 November 2017 at the request of shareholders. The business of that meeting related to the proposed removal and appointment of directors. The second was held on 5 April 2018, primarily to seek shareholder approval for the acquisition of the business assets of Gruden Group Limited ("Gruden").

The Group incurred \$0.9m in one-off costs relating to these meetings, \$0.5m to 31 December 2017 and a further \$0.4m to 30 June 2018.

5.6. Acquisition costs

On 11 May 2018 the Company acquired the business assets of ASX-Listed Gruden Group Limited ("Gruden"), a digital marketing and transactional payment business with 500,000 users across 800 retail outlets handling 100,000 transactions per month.

In this acquisition, IncentiaPay acquired the following new, wholly owned, subsidiaries:

- Gruden Pty Ltd ACN 602 396 654
- Blackglass Pty Ltd ACN 114 807 340
- MobileDen Pty Ltd ACN 159 196 620

Costs associated with the acquisition included accounting and financial due diligence and advice (\$0.4m) and legal due diligence and advice (\$0.4m).

5.7. Other significant items

Other significant items incurred during FY2018 primarily relate to the Employee Share Option Plan (ESOP) approved at the April EGM. The FY2018 non-cash cost of all issued ESOP's was \$0.7m.

6. Dividends

During FY2018 the IncentiaPay Group announced a fully franked dividend of 2.25 cents per share in relation to the Company's results for the year ended 30 June 2017. A total of \$2.6m was paid to shareholders in relation to this dividend on 6 January 2018.

No dividend has been declared in relation to the FY2018 results. Investors should note that the Board of Directors of IncentiaPay Ltd do not expect to declare dividends from the Company during the current restructuring period.
