Leigh Creek Energy Limited (ASX: LCK) Request for Voluntary Suspension

I refer to the request from Leigh Creek Energy Limited (ASX: LCK) (the "Company") on Monday 1 October 2018 for a trading halt of its ordinary securities quoted on the Australian Securities Exchange (ASX).

The trading halt was requested to enable the Company to manage its continuous disclosure obligations pending an announcement regarding the initiation of gasification at the Leigh Creek Energy Project. Until an announcement regarding this initiation, the Company requests voluntary suspension to the quotation of its ordinary shares on the ASX.

Pursuant to Listing Rule 17.2 the Company provides the following information in relation to this request:

- 1. The reason for the request for voluntary suspension is for the Company to manage its continuous disclosure obligations in relation to the initiation of gasification at the Leigh Creek Energy Project.
- 2. The Company requests the voluntary suspension to continue until the earlier of the release of the announcement, or commencement of trading on Thursday 4 October 2018.
- 3. The event that will end the voluntary suspension is the announcement referred to in the second paragraph above.

The Company is not aware of any reason why the voluntary suspension should not be granted.
