# **Sydney Airport Traffic Performance September 2018**

Sydney Airport CEO Geoff Culbert said, "Total and International passengers grew 0.4% and 1.7% respectively during the month of September compared to the prior corresponding period (pcp).

"September was impacted primarily by the school holiday period falling later this year compared to last. Pleasingly, total and international passengers grew 2.9% and 4.8% respectively for the calendar year to date compared to the pcp.

"Nationals from the USA (+8.3%), India (+13.6%) and Japan (+15.7%) recorded notably strong growth, with those from Malaysia (+12.2%) also contributing to the overall performance.

"This month also saw two very positive announcements from the Commonwealth Government who have delivered improved bilateral air services arrangements with Fiji and the Philippines. Both agreements will increase the number of available seats for airlines of both countries and will potentially provide growth opportunities for Sydney Airport."
