

Total Progression of Optic fibre Infrastructure










Our growth drivers



Demand for bandwidth in Asia Pacific– Increased data consumption, growth of cloud computing, drives demand for Superloop's connectivity infrastructure


Optic fiber infrastructure – 671km of optic fiber across Australia, Singapore and Hong Kong metro regions as at 30 June 2018; Superloop drives significant incremental gross margins from its network infrastructure

Fixed cost leverage – Superloop is able to generate high margin returns on incremental capacity usage on our networks

Strategic Sites – 310 strategic sites across Australia, Singapore and Hong Kong metro regions as at 30 June 2018; Superloop monetises the significant transfer of consumer and business data between data centre sites

Customers and contracts – Superloop has long duration contracts, with the network effect driving a sticky customer portfolio and recurring revenue stream


- Launch of Superloop 360v2 capable of centralising all connectivity provisioning
