Update on Copyright Tribunal Proceedings

Isentia Group Limited (ASX:ISD) announces that, after market close on Friday afternoon 16 November 2018, its subsidiary Isentia Pty Limited received from the Copyright Tribunal of Australia the Reasons for Determination (**Reasons**) in its application for an interim copyright licence.

Some of the key points contained in the Reasons are:

- The interim licence will apply from 1 December 2018 for a period of three months and the Tribunal will then review the position with a view to establishing a further interim licence;
- The Tribunal's final ruling on the principal application will be retroactive to 1 December 2018; and
- While the interim licence will be on different terms than Isentia's current licence, the
 rates that will apply under the interim licence are in a Confidential Schedule that has not
 yet been released to Isentia, nor has the Tribunal made orders giving effect to the
 Reasons.

Isentia and Copyright Agency Limited are now required to submit to the Tribunal within 10 days proposed orders giving effect to the Reasons, following which the Tribunal will make orders.

On the information currently available to Isentia there is no change to previously advised FY19 guidance.
