GetSwift to appeal judgement

On 23 May 2018, GetSwift Limited (ASX: GSW) ("GetSwift" or "the Company") advised that the Federal Court of Australia had ordered that only 1 of 3 competing class actions filed against the Company could continue.

That decision was appealed to the Full Court of the Federal Court of Australia. The Full Court handed down its decision today, 20 November 2018.

The Court upheld the judgement at first instance, holding that only 1 class action proceeds. The Company is pleased with this decision, which accords with its submissions. The Company will be seeking its costs incurred in respect of this carriage motion.

As previously advised, the Company strongly disputes the allegations made, including any alleged loss, and is vigorously defending the proceedings. The Company will continue to keep shareholders informed of developments.
