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1. Chairman's letter

Dear Shareholder,

On behalf of the Directors, I am pleased to invite you, as a valued Shareholder of Tamawood Limited (**TWD** or the **Company**), to participate in TWD's recently announced fully underwritten 1 for 40 non-renounceable entitlement offer of new TWD ordinary shares (**New Shares**) at an issue price of \$3.65 per New Share to raise approximately \$2,338,935 (**Entitlement Offer**).

The issue price of \$3. 65 per New Share represents a 6.4% discount to the three-day volumeweighted average Share price (being \$3.90 as at 11 March 2019). Allotment of the New Shares issued under the Entitlement Offer will occur on 17 April 2019.

It is proposed that the funds raised from the Capital Raising will be used for the following purposes.

Reasons for the Capital Raising

As recently announced to market on 27 February 2019, TWD has proposed a small capital raising which will be underwritten by Mr Lev Mizikovsky (See section 3.7). The Company intends to utilise the funds to assist with working capital requirements to fund the anticipated growth in Work in Progress over the next 3-9 months as a result of the improvement in appointments, enquiries and contract sales. Traditionally there is significant cash outlay at the beginning of each signed contract from start through to slab and frame stages. Under the standard HIA industry contracts, the company can only issue claims of 30% of the contract value during this stage and the gap needs to be funded from working capital.

2. Entitlement Offer Details

2.1 The Entitlement Offer

The Entitlement Offer is an offer to Eligible Shareholders of an estimated 640,804 New Shares at an Issue Price of \$3.65 per New Share, on the basis of 1 New Share for every 40 Shares held (**Entitlement**), to raise approximately \$2,338.935 (before costs).

On the same date as announcing the Entitlement Offer, the Company applied to the ASX for the New Shares to be granted official quotation on the ASX. Official quotation of the New Shares is expected to occur on or about 18 April 2019.

The issue price of \$3.65 per New Share represents a 6.4% discount to the three-day volume-weighted average Share price (being \$3.90) as at 11 March 2019.

The Entitlement Offer is non-renounceable. Accordingly, Entitlements do not trade on the ASX, and they cannot be transferred or otherwise disposed of.

2.6 Allotment and allocation

The Company will proceed to allocate New Shares as soon as possible after the Closing Date and receiving ASX permission for official quotation of the New Shares.

3.2 Capital structure

Subject to rounding up of fractional Entitlements and assuming none of the Existing Options are exercised before the Record Date, the capital structure of TWD following the issue of New Shares under the Capital Raising (assuming full subscription under the Entitlement Offer) is expected to be as follows:

3.3 Potential effects of the Entitlement Offer on Control of TWD

The Entitlement Offer is a pro-rata offer so that if all Eligible Shareholders take up their Entitlements and none of the Option Holders exercise their Existing Options and participate in the Entitlement Offer, the existing Voting Power of all Eligible Shareholders will remain the same.

However, if some Shareholders take up their Entitlements, Shareholders who do not take up all of their Entitlements will have their interest in TWD diluted.

The Company seeks to make the Entitlement Offer to all Shareholders and has extended the Entitlement Offer to Shareholders with registered addresses in the Prescribed Jurisdictions. Accordingly, if all other Shareholders take up their Entitlement, foreign Shareholders with registered addresses in the Prescribed Jurisdiction (at the date of this Offer Booklet) will not be diluted as a consequence of the Entitlement Offer, unless they elect not to take up their Entitlements.

3.4 Related Party

As a Director, Mr Lev Mizikovsky is also a substantial shareholder of TWD. His intention is to participate for his 100% entitlement under the Capital Raising. The effect of a change in ownership is reflected in Section 3.5 and 3.6 of this Offer Booklet.

3.5 Underwriting and Directors' Intentions

Mr Lev Mizikovsky, a Director of the Company, has agreed to fully underwrite the Entitlement Offer through a related entity and current Shareholder, Poltick Pty Ltd. A summary of the Directors (and their associates) current shareholdings, Mr Lev Mizikovsky's underwriting amount and the maximum effect of his underwriting commitment is set out below. The Directors' direct and indirect interests in the Company as at the date of the announcement of the Entitlement Offer are as follows:

Each of the Directors has shown their support for the Entitlement Offer by indicating that they intend to subscribe for their full Entitlement.

3.6 Change of Control

As at the date of this Offer Booklet, Mr Mizikovsky (and his associates) hold 12,658,275 Shares, comprising approximately 49.38% of the Shares in the Company. Mr Lev Mizikovsky (and his associates) therefore have an Entitlement to 316,457 New Shares under the Entitlement Offer in their capacity as Eligible Shareholders.

If there is a shortfall, then subject to the terms of the Underwriting Agreement, Mr Mizikovsky, through a related entity, Poltick Pty Ltd, is obliged to take up the shortfall. If no Eligible Shareholders take up their Entitlements, then Mr Mizikovsky and his associates, including the Underwriter Politick Pty Ltd, will be required to take up all of the 640,804 New Shares under the Entitlement Offer. If this were to occur then the total number of shares held by Mr Mizikovsky (and his associates) will increase from 12,658,275 to 13,299,079 and the voting power of Mr Lev Mizikovsky (and his associates) will increase from 49.38% to a maximum of 50.62%.

Ultimately, the effect of the Rights Issue on control depends on the extent to which Eligible Shareholders take up their Entitlements under the Entitlement Offer.

3.7 Underwriting Terms

Pursuant to the Underwriting Agreement the Underwriter has agreed to fully underwrite the Entitlement Offer. The Underwriter will not receive any underwriting fees or other benefits in return for underwriting the Entitlement Offer.

The Company has given limited warranties and covenants in favour of the Underwriter.

Shareholder approval will not be sought for the purpose of Listing Rule 10.11, as the issue of Shortfall Shares to the Underwriter under the Underwriting Agreement will come within Exception 2 of Listing Rule 10.12 (which provides that shareholder approval is not required to issue securities to a related party where the entity receives the securities under an

underwriting agreement in relation to a pro-rata issue and the terms of the underwriting were included in the offer documents sent to shareholders).

Issue of New Shares

The Company expects that the New Shares will be issued by no later than 17 April 2019. The issue of New Shares will only be made after permission for their quotation on ASX has been granted.

Underwritten Shares will be applied for and issued in accordance with the Underwriting Agreement and, in any event, no later than 15 Business Days after the Closing Date, so as to comply with the exception to Listing Rule 7.1 for shares issued under an underwriting agreement to an underwriter of a pro rata offer of shares.
