Sydney Airport CEO Geoff Culbert said, "Sydney Airport facilitated 1.4 million passengers travelling internationally in April and nearly 2.3 million passengers domestically.

"International passenger numbers outperformed the prior corresponding period by 2.5%, while Domestic passenger numbers declined by 1.3% compared to April 2018. International passenger growth was positively impacted by the shift in Easter timing.

"We saw double digit growth from both United States and Filipino travellers, increasing 13.2% and 12.1% respectively.

"Domestically, subdued load factors and continued capacity management by airlines drove a reduction in domestic passengers for the month despite the later Easter holiday."
