Update on acquisition of Infant Formula Plant

- Due diligence investigations on Infant Formula plant now complete and the Board is satisfied with the results
- Relocation works commenced this week
- Plant now expected to arrive in Australia ahead of schedule in late July.

The Board of Australian Dairy Nutritionals Group (the **Group** or **AHF**) is pleased to advise that it has now completed and is satisfied with its due diligence investigations in relation to the purchase of the Infant Formula plant announced to ASX on 4 April 2019.

Decommissioning and dismantling works commenced this week with the Plant now expected to arrive in Australia in late July 2019, ahead of the previously advised date of September 2019. The Group expects to complete the acquisition of the Plant in August 2019, shortly after its arrival in Australia.

This is a major milestone in the Group's strategy to become one of Australia's first vertically integrated manufacturers of organic infant formula. The purchase of an existing operational plant will accelerate the Group's entry into the organic infant formula market in a sensible staged manner without the initial, much higher capital cost and longer construction lead time of a large dryer with higher capacity.

The Group is heavily focussed on its strategy to shift away from production of conventional white milk to concentrate on value added own brands and premium dairy products and the purchase of this plant is a key part of the execution of this strategy. Furthermore, the Board believes the Group's provenance story will be particularly attractive to consumers as milk will be sourced from the Group's own organic farms in Western Victoria and processed just half an hour away at the Group's own processing facility in Camperdown.
