This notice is given by Emperor Energy Limited (Company) under Section 708A(5)(e) of the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth) (Corporations Act).

The Company hereby confirms that:

- (a) it has issued a total of 116,600,000 fully paid ordinary shares (**Shares**) at an issue price of \$0.003 (0.3 cents) per Share and 116,600,000 listed options (**Options**), exercisable at \$0.005, on or before 31 March 2020;
- (b) the Shares and Options were issued without disclosure to investors under Part 6D.2 of the Corporations Act;
- (c) the Company is providing this notice under paragraph 5(e) of section 708A of the Corporations Act;
- (d) as at the date of this notice the Company, as a disclosing entity under the Corporations Act, has complied with:
 - (i) the provisions of Chapter 2M of the Corporations Act as they apply to the Company; and
 - (ii) section 674 of the Corporations Act as it applies to the Company; and
