Sydney Airport CEO Geoff Culbert said, "The number of International passengers travelling through the Airport last month grew by 1.1 per cent to 1.3 million passengers compared to the prior corresponding period and Domestic passengers reduced by 1.6 percent to 2.1 million passengers.

"More than 3.4 million passengers passed through Sydney Airport in June 2019, 0.5 per cent down on June 2018.

"Sydney's top five fastest growing passenger groups over the month were Vietnam, Taiwan, Japan, USA and India, all recording double digit growth compared to June 2018.

"Domestic passenger numbers were impacted by capacity reductions combined with subdued load factors."
