Cash on hand at 30 June 2019 totalled \$491,000. June 2019 cash on hand is expected to cover cash outflows during the September 2019 quarter, with \$267,000 cash on hand expected at 30 September 2019. The Company expects that funds will be available to finance future operations and that realisation of assets and settlement of liabilities will occur in the normal course of business. The Company would raise additional funds before committing to further operating cash outflows of the same scale. The Company expects to continue to have negative operating cash flows whist it seeks new growth opportunities and develops its HMS and rare earth potential in the Murray Basin. In order to commercialise opportunities and generate future revenues, additional funding will be required.
