Company announcement: Investec Australia Property Fund (ASX: IAP) Request for trading halt

Under Listing Rule 17.1, Investec Property Limited (ABN 93 071 514 246) ("Responsible Entity"), in its capacity as responsible entity of Investec Australia Property Fund (ARSN 162 067 736) (the "Fund"), requests a trading halt in the Fund's units.

The trading halt is being requested:

- to enable an announcement to be made to the market of a significant transaction, involving a
 material acquisition partly funded by an underwritten placement ("Placement"); and
- because it is necessary to prevent a disorderly market occurring in units in the Fund while the Placement is being conducted.

The trading halt is requested from the commencement of trading on Thursday, 26 September 2019 until the earlier of the commencement of trading on Friday, 27 September 2019 or the making of an announcement to the market regarding the outcome of the Placement on ASX.

The Responsible Entity is not aware of any reason why the trading halt should not be granted or of any other information necessary to inform the market about the trading halt.
