BSA secures extension of nbn OMMA contract to December 2020

Sydney, 26 September 2019: BSA Limited (ASX:BSA) is pleased to announce that it has today secured an extension to its Operate and Maintain Master Agreement (OMMA) contract with NBN Co (nbn) to 31 December 2020 for the ongoing service and maintenance of its fixed-line infrastructure network.

The extension will see BSA continue to provide nbn with a range of activation and assurance services to its Fibre to the Premise (FTTP), Fibre to the Node (FTTN), Fibre to the Basement (FTTB) fibre to the Curb (FTTC) and Hybrid Fibre Coax (HFC) network infrastructure nationally.

The extension will be on similar commercial terms to the existing contract and while this does not include volume guarantees as per nbn practice, BSA estimates the extension will provide similar historical revenues as those to date on an annualised basis.

Commenting on the extension, BSA Managing Director Nicholas Yates said, "We are very pleased to secure an extension to the OMMA contract and remain committed to building on our strong relationship with nbn. We have been working closely with nbn for over 4 years and have been providing market leading performance levels. We continue to expand the nature and geographic coverage of our services and we look forward to continuing to work with nbn in support of its network infrastructure into the future."
