## Sydney Airport Traffic Performance September 2019

Sydney Airport CEO Geoff Culbert said, “Our international passenger performance in September is a continuation of the growth we saw in August. International passenger numbers were up 1.9 percent on September 2018 and growth is holding steady at 1.4 percent year to date.

“Domestic passenger numbers were up 1.2 percent on the September 2018 figures, only the second time this year we’ve seen growth on the corresponding month in 2018.

“Arrivals from India recorded their second consecutive month of double-digit growth, up 11.2 percent on September 2018 and up 8.4 percent year to date. We’re supportive of Federal Tourism Minister Simon Birmingham’s focus on India which reflects the growth and potential we are seeing.

“A highlight for September was the air services agreement between Australia and Nepal, which aligns to the strong passenger growth we’ve experienced in recent years. Indonesian passenger growth was another highlight, posting 16.1 percent growth on September 2018.”
