



lan Plimer BSc (Hons), PhD, Hon. FGS, FTSE

lan is Emeritus Professor of Earth Sciences at The University of Melbourne where he was Professor and Head (1991-2005). He was Professor and Head of Geology (University of Newcastle 1985-1991), Professor of Ore Deposit Geology at Ludwig Maximilians Universität (Munich, 1991) and Professor of Mining Geology (University of Adelaide 2006-2011). Professor Plimer has published more than 130 scientific papers (including scores of papers on Broken Hill), edited the five-volume *Encyclopedia of Geology* and is author of eleven books for the general public.

Mid-career, he was senior research geologist with North Broken Hill Ltd and has consulted worldwide to major exploration companies and governments on mineral exploration and ore deposits.
