Therefore, it is essential for you to provide details of your nominated Australian financial institution account for receipt of interest payments. Otherwise, you will not receive interest payments on each payment date.



Your securityholder communication elections. You can elect to access all your securityholder communications online (e.g. interest payment statements) and receive notification by email when they are available.



Your Tax File Number/Australian Business Number (TFN/ABN) and/or Exemption Codes. If you are an Australian resident or subject to Australia's taxation laws, it is in your interests to provide us your Tax File Number or Australian Business Number as soon as possible.
