**Uzatom and Worley have entered into a joint venture agreement**

The Atomic Energy Development Agency of the Republic of Uzbekistan (Uzatom), has entered into a joint venture agreement with Worley. The joint venture, Uzatom Worley Engineering LLC, will form the engineering and project management organization of Uzatom. The joint venture will provide engineering services for nuclear power facilities and nuclear infrastructure in Uzbekistan, including expert evaluation, project management and consulting services to Uzatom and other customers.

Currently Uzatom is progressing an initiative to construct a nuclear power plant in Uzbekistan with 2 reactor units providing total capacity of 2.4GW.
