Dulles Greenway Application for Future Toll Price Schedule

Further to the announcement by Atlas Arteria (**ASX: ALX**) yesterday that an application has been filed with the Virginia State Corporation Commissions (the **Commission**) seeking approval for an increase in the maximum level of tolls for the Dulles Greenway (the **Application**), a copy of the Application and supporting materials are now available on the Atlas Arteria website under the Dulles Greenway tab (www.atlasarteria.com.au/portfolio/dulles-greenway).

As reported earlier, any increase requires approval by the Commission pursuant to the Virginia Highway Corporation Act of 1988, § 56-535 et seq. of the Code of Virginia and a final outcome on the Application is expected within the next 12 months.
