ASX ANNOUNCEMENT – THREDBO RESUMES SUMMER RESORT OPERATIONS

EVENT Hospitality & Entertainment Limited (the "Group") today advised that following notification

from the New South Wales Rural Fire Service ("NSW RFS") and New South Wales National Parks and

Wildlife Service ("NPWS"), the Thredbo Alpine Resort ("Thredbo") will resume summer resort

operations from Tuesday 14 January 2020. This follows the temporary closure of Thredbo due to

bushfires in Kosciuszko National Park (the "Park") as announced on 2 January 2020.

All in-resort operations including mountain biking will resume tomorrow. However, areas in the Park

outside of Thredbo remain closed until further notice including the Thredbo Valley Trail, Mount

Kosciuszko Summit Walk, Dead Horse Gap Walk and a few other trails.

Thredbo will remain in daily contact with NSW RFS and NPWS to stay informed on bush fire activity

and conditions. The safety of residents, staff and our guests remains the highest priority and should

conditions change, these authorities may direct Thredbo to evacuate the resort and the market will

be informed if that occurs.

Whilst the impact of the temporary closure is not currently material to the Group's earnings, the

Group expects a slow business recovery whilst the broader Park area remains closed.
