Correction to Toll Revenue and Traffic Statistics for Q4 2019 Announcement

Atlas Arteria (ASX:ALX) wishes to announce a correction to the release made on 29 January 2020 regarding the Toll Revenue and Traffic Statistics for Q4 2019.

In that announcement, it was noted that in relation to Dulles Greenway: "The removal of the last remaining traffic light on the competing Route 7 at the start of the quarter also impacted traffic."

This should have read: "The most recent removal of a traffic light on the competing Route 7 at the start of the quarter also impacted traffic."

There are two remaining traffic lights along Route 7 between the Leesburg Bypass and the Route 28 Interchange.

In Germany, we own 100% of the Warnow Tunnel in the north-east city of Rostock.

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
