### Sun Minerals vendors elect to voluntary escrow period

Mithril Resources Limited ASX: MTH) ("MTH" or the "Company") is pleased to advise that it has received confirmation from key vendors of Sun Minerals Pty Ltd (Sun Minerals) of their willingness to enter into (or procure the entry of) voluntary escrow arrangements in respect of approximately 97% of the fully paid ordinary shares proposed to be issued to the vendors of Sun Minerals as consideration for MTH's acquisition of Sun Minerals (the "Transaction"), will be for a period of 24-months from the date of issue.

The issue of fully paid ordinary shares as consideration to the vendors of Sun Minerals, as approved by shareholders at a general meeting on 12 February 2020, remain conditional upon satisfaction of the conditions to, and completion of, the Transaction. The fully paid ordinary shares to be issued will represent approximately 39% of the shares on issue in the Company post the completion of the Transaction.

Sun Minerals holds an exclusive option to earn up to a 100% interest in the high-grade Copalquin Gold Silver Project located in the Sierra Madre Trend, Durango State, Western Mexico.

Commenting on the voluntary escrow period, MTH Non-Executive Director and Company Secretary, Mr Adrien Wing, said:

"Securing the long-term support of the team at Sun Minerals is an important step as we progress with this transformative Transaction for MTH shareholders. It is well known that the Sun Minerals Directors have a strong pedigree, with over 50 years of combined Mexico operating experience, along with a track record of success managing public companies and developing gold/silver projects in Australia and internationally. We wish to thank the Sun Minerals Directors and look forward to working with them on the Copalquin Project."

In addition, attached please find a copy of Appendix 3G and applicable Appendix 3Y's for the issue of performance rights to Mr Adrien Wing and Mr Stephen Layton. Over and above the milestone requirements for conversion set out under the rights, the vesting and therefore the benefit of these rights remain conditional upon completion of the Transaction.
