INFIGEN ANNOUNCES FEBRUARY 2020 MONTHLY PRODUCTION

Infigen (ASX: IFN) today reported unaudited production for February 2020 as follows:

On 31 January 2020, a major transmission line connecting the Victoria and South Australia electricity markets was damaged, causing significant disruption to system operations. As a result, the Australian Energy Market Operator (AEMO) curtailed production from a number of generators including Infigen's Lake Bonney 1, 2 and 3 wind farms. As indicated at the H1FY20 results on 21 February 2020, the strong performance of Infigen's 25MW/52MWh SA battery has broadly offset the economic impact of the curtailed production. The transmission line has now been restored.

During February 2020, Production Sold from the Smithfield OCGT was 1GWh. Smithfield is a gas peaking facility where annual capacity utilisation is expected to be in the range of 2-8%, with significant variations in output expected from month to month.


² Owned Renewable Energy Assets refers to Infigen's seven owned wind farms.

³ Production Generated is subject to marginal loss factors (MLFs) that are fixed annually by the Australian Energy Market Operator to account for network losses. Production Sold reflects the impact of these MLFs.

⁴ Contracted Assets refer to production acquired under run of plant PPAs where Infigen is the offtaker. Production from Contracted Assets commenced with Kiata Wind Farm in September 2018 and includes Toora Wind Farm from January 2020.
