Covid-19 Restrictions - Business Update

Like all businesses worldwide the Company is being impacted by extensive government mandated Covid-19 restrictions in its Australian and overseas markets, particularly in its automotive segment.

The Company's licensee, DataDot Technology South Africa (Pty) Ltd has advised that nonessential manufacturing has entered a mandatory shut down until at least 16 April which will have a negative impact on both its local automotive supply as well as supply to Toyota Europe which is expected to be impacted by reduced vehicle sales in the European market.

The Company's North American distributor has also advised that it expects that its volume of automotive kits will be substantially reduced in the immediate term in line with the expected fall in vehicle sales in its market.

The full financial impact of the Covid-19 restrictions cannot be determined at this time as this will be dependent on the ultimate extent and duration of the restrictions. To minimise the impact of the expected reduction in revenue forecasts DDT will utilise all applicable Federal and State Government support packages and is undertaking an immediate review of its operating and fixed costs structures.

This announcement has been approved by the Board of Directors of DDT.
