### Aguia Resources Limited – Request for Trading Halt

Pursuant to ASX Listing Rule 17.1 and the grant of class waivers pursuant to ASX Listing Rule 18.1 as announced by ASX on 31 March 2020 (**Class Waivers**), Aguia Resources Limited (**Aguia**) requests two consecutive back-to-back trading halts for up to four consecutive days in its fully paid ordinary shares (ASX Code: AGR), from the commencement of trading on Tuesday, 14 April 2020.

In accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.1 and for the purposes of the Class Waivers, Aguia provides the following information:

- a) **Reason for trading halt:** the trading halt is requested for the purpose of considering a capital raising.
- b) **Duration of the trading halt:** Aguia requests that the trading halt continue until the earlier of such time as it makes an announcement to the market or the commencement of trading on Monday, 20 April 2020.
- c) **Termination of the trading halt:** Aguia anticipates that the trading halt will cease upon it making an announcement to the market.
- d) No reason: Aguia is not aware of any reason why the trading halt should not be granted by ASX.
- e) **Further information:** Aguia is not aware of any further information which needs to be disclosed to the market at the time of seeking the trading halt.
