First orders received for new tablet-based solution for COVID-19

16 April 2020. Oneview Healthcare PLC (ASX: ONE) a global healthcare technology company, has officially launched a cloud-based tablet solution to help healthcare systems and providers better manage hospitalized patients during and after the COVID-19 crisis.

Oneview Cloud for COVID-19 enables virtual rounds; virtual visitations (allows patients to call friends and family); and virtual interpretation services. The tablet also provides patients with up-to-date information on COVID-19, as well as education and entertainment content. Other Android apps can be added if required.

The first deployment of the new product is underway, with NYU Langone Health, one of the nation's premier academic medical centers in New York, where the COVID-19 crisis has been escalating rapidly. NYU Langone Health is deploying Oneview's newly launched Cloud for COVID-19 tablet solution this week, with more than 370 additional tablets across multiple hospitals.

Oneview is also working with its clients, including Mater Group in Brisbane and Chris O'Brien Lifehouse in Sydney to deploy virtual rounding and virtual visitation on their existing Oneview platforms.

The new Oneview Cloud technology is designed for rapid deployment and does not require new infrastructure, on-site servers or integrations with other systems. The tablet does require access to Wi-Fi and a point-to-point VPN to the Oneview Azure infrastructure.

Other features of the Oneview Cloud for COVID-19 include:

- Auto-answer capabilities for inbound video calls in the patient room (with compatible enterprise video solutions)
- Tablets come pre-configured for immediate deployment
- Devices are locked-down to prevent configuration changes and remotely monitored 24/7/365 to ensure they stay operational
- Cloud-based dashboard for utilization analytics
- Access to a menu of communication applications including Cisco Jabber, Zoom, Microsoft Teams and other enterprise video solutions with Android apps
- Access to entertainment streaming sites such as Netflix and Amazon Prime Video
- No need for Oneview staff to access patient rooms

When a patient is discharged, the device is digitally wiped of all user data, sanitised, and is ready for the next patient.

Oneview CEO James Fitter commented: "Healthcare organisations are having to rapidly adapt now to ensure they can deploy critical resources where they are needed the most and one of the big changes is to the daily "rounds" to monitor patients.



Unifying the care experience.

This is extremely difficult during a pandemic because of the need for clinicians to wear personal protective equipment (PPE) which is in short supply. Our solution enables “virtual rounds”, eliminating unnecessary exposure between clinicians and patients, preserving scarce PPE and ensuring clinicians are being deployed for critical clinical care.
