## Market Update – Major training milestone reached

### Site Skills Training to reach 200,000 enrolments by the end of the financial year

The Directors of Site Group International Limited (“Site”, ASX:SIT) are pleased to announce that Site Skills Training (SST) is expected to reach the milestone of 200,000 enrolments by 30 June 2020. To date the SST business has delivered training for over 199,600 enrolments.

With the addition of training delivered by Wild Geese International and Site Institute, along with training delivered via overseas operations, more than 221,000 enrolments for training with respective Site businesses.

Delivery for Australian accreditation programs comes with completion and satisfaction rates above 92%. Indigenous participation in Australia is over 3.6% of total cohorts enabling skills that result in and furthers employment.

Significantly over 73% of trainees are employer-initiated enrolments from Australia’s most critical industries of Mining, Oil and Gas as well as Construction representing Australia’s largest and smallest employers alike.

Internationally Site continues to train for Industry and Governments in Philippines, Papua New Guinea, East Timor, Myanmar, Kingdom of Saudi Arabia (KSA) and Bahrain with many candidates from disadvantaged backgrounds learning lifelong industry skills for employment.

In addition to accreditations in Australia, Site subsidiaries deliver under a range of international standards. These include City and Guild (UK) American Welding Standard (AWS), ASME and OPITO.

### Contract updates

Whilst COVID-19 continues to impact global markets, Site remains confident of extending and expanding its contracts in KSA and Bahrain with ongoing discussions around delivery of new cohorts for KSA in line with the National Saudization program.

Discussions are also advancing with Bahrain Polytechnic on delivery of Site’s Engineering Work Experience Program (EWEP) with the objective of installing a Safe Live Process Plant (SLPP) in Bahrain.

Training is expected to return to Myanmar in September and October for the EWEP program for graduating engineers.

In Philippines welding training for local projects has resumed, a local energy company is initiating new mechanical, electrical and instrumentation programs and GE is expected to resume training for its turbine and shut down teams when commercial flights return in a few months.

## **Clark property**

Discussions in relation to the development of the Clark property are likely to resume in July with several parties emerging from lockdown expressing interest in renewal of discussions. Site is still committed to selecting a path forward by end of this calendar year.
