



Western Australia Gold & Base Metals

- 623km² of gold and base metal prospects acquired ⁽¹⁾
- Located in the Yalgoo / Mount Magnet districts of Western Australia
- Accessible low-cost assets with near surface potential

Priority Gold targets include:

- High grade rock chips yet to be tested at depth:
 - 8gpt quartz vein reported at Warriedar (2)
- Historic drilling never followed up:
 - 15m @ 2.33 gpt (including 7m @ 3.4gpt) at Euro (3)






The Forgotten Goldfield

Yalgoo Mineral Field

- Rich historic and modern mining history: high grade producer
- 100km long belt with notable mineral occurrences every 1km
- World class deposits every 10-20km (gold, copper, zinc, tungsten and iron ore)
- Major infrastructure already in place (rail, roads, power, communications, water)
- 400km from Perth (low cost, high impact exploration)

Li3 Projects

- >600km2 of highly prospective ground
- 20-30km continuation of stratigraphy that host world class Golden Grove (Zinc/Copper/Silver/Gold) and Minjar (1MOz Au) mines
- Large structures suitable for formation of major deposits




Yalgoo mineral field simplified geology and large scale mines

Huge potential

- 333km² of granted tenure
- Optionality of commodities and mineralization types
- Located within 20km of the Minjar and Golden Grove mines
- >25km of previously unrecognized greenstone and felsic volcanics highly prospective for gold and base metals
- 2x5km intrusive gold target zone
- Recently completed phase 1 exploration
- Further sampling and drilling planned for 2020

A new history - a new discovery?

Past

- Historical maps and interpretations show the Warriedar area to be barren granites
- Area remained unexplored
- Li3Company modelling (2019) showed the possibility of greenstones and volcanic sequences

Present

- Fieldwork in 2020 showed
 - Outcropping 20-30km previously unrecognized stratigraphy capable of hosting world class mines
 - Geochemical anomalies proving rocks are metal bearing (1)

Future

- Further fieldwork to rationalize geological detail
- Drilling priority targets



The next Golden Grove?

- 2020 exploration programs targeting Volcanogenic Massive Sulphide (VMS)
- Large scale 500m x 5000m spaced geochemical program
- Exciting Gold and Base Metal anomalies detected (1)
 - Planned works for 2020/21 include:
 - Geophysical data reprocessing
 - Infill geochemical sampling
 - Rab drilling
 - Targeted drilling



Intrusive Gold

- High grade vein gold (8gpt) and surface gold
- 2020 exploration programs targeting Intrusive Relation Gold Systems (IRGS)
- Wide spaced 500m x 500m reconnaissance geochemical program conducted
- Large zone of highly anomalous indicator elements indicative of of IRG System were detected (1)
 - Planned works for 2020 include:
 - Follow up on anomalous zones
 - Infill geochemical sampling
 - Drill target finalisation
 - Drilling

Warriedar schematic geology and IRGS indicator geochemistry (As Bi Mo Sb Te W) Li3 tenements in blue (white areas excluded)



Further Golden Grove Potential

- 93km² granted tenure
- Gold discovered in 1907 Extensive artisanal gold production
- Minimal modern exploration
- Located near the EMR Golden Grove base and precious metal mine
- Golden Grove Unit outcrops (VMS potential)
- Outcropping ultramafic hosted quartz lodes (gold potential)
- Reconnaissance mapping conducted May 2020 awaiting rock chip assays
 - Planned works for 2020/21 include:
 - Geochemical survey
 - Geological modelling




Near Surface Gold






