Q4 FY20 Activity Report and Appendix 4C

Pureprofile Limited (ASX: **PPL** or the **Company**) is pleased to present the following activity report and attached Appendix 4C for the quarter ended 30 June 2020.

The Company's closing cash balance at the end of the quarter was up on the previous quarter by **220% to \$1.7m**, (Q3 FY20: \$764k).

Net cash from operating activities was up on the previous quarter by **500% to \$1.5m**, an improvement on Q3 FY20 where net cash from operating activities was \$301k. This was primarily due to a reduction in operating expenses (Q4 FY20: \$5.6m; Q3 FY20: \$6.6m). Various factors contributed to the reduction, including pay cuts or a reduction in working hours for all employees and contractors. The Company also received \$264k from the Jobkeeper allowance.

A reduction in software development expenses reduced net cash used in investing activities from (\$654k) in Q3 FY20 to (\$485k) for Q4 FY20.

Net cash from financing activities for Q4 FY20 was nil (Q3 FY20: \$0.55m).

Following the quarter, on 13 July 2020, the Company announced the appointment of Mr Martin Filz as Chief Executive Officer, effective 3 August 2020. It is expected that Mr Filz will also be appointed to the board at the same time and Andrew Edwards will revert back to Non-Executive Chairman.
